

Self Data Territorial / SELF DATA CITIES

Sept 2018 – Sept 2019

This year, MestInfos is focusing on a very specific subject: Territorial Self Data. Greater Lyon, La Rochelle and Nantes Métropole, each inhabited by the ambition to implement Self Data locally, are partners in the project. What if cities took a central role in animating, coordinating, facilitating and promoting Self Data with private, public and civil society actors?



While territories are facing unprecedented challenges (environmental, economic, social, planning and development), the vision of the "smart" is becoming increasingly important: more intelligent systems and services to optimize flows, reduce risks and consumption... Can we imagine another vision, less centralized, more open, that gives a new place to citizens and the various actors of the territory?

After more than 6 years of exploring and testing self data, it is time to pass the torch. Fing has always carried out a mission as an activator of Self Data, bringing together private actors, public actors, innovation ecosystem. What if cities take on this role?

As key players in the relationship with individuals, data holders themselves or via their private service providers, disrupted by digital players trading in personal data, engaging Smart City logic that generates more and more data, local public actors have an essential task before them: rebalancing the balance of power and information asymmetry between citizens and organizations.

Three cities, each with a different theme, are working with Fing and its partners to devise ways of implementing data sharing with individuals (Self Data). To 1) enable individuals to take control of their data, individually or in common 2) contribute, through their data or through specific uses, to the management of the territory, to causes of general interest...:

- Nantes Métropole on the energy transition with its local partners Ademe, Enedis, Engie, GRDF and EDF.
- Greater Lyon on the themes of social development/social work
- La Rochelle on mobility with its local partners: Ademe/La Fabrique des mobilités, in connection with the mobility account.

The project is being carried out in three phases between October 2018 and September 2019, in each of the territories:

- Phase I - Mapping personal data that could be shared with individuals
- Phase II - Imagine the use cases mobilizing these data and their governance (personal cloud platform, cooperative, direct third-party services, etc.)

- Phase III - Design a territorial implementation kit for 2020 (round table, financial, technical, legal and technical conditions, etc.)

DELIVERABLES :

- FEBRUARY 2019: Mapping of Data that could be shared with individuals (work in progress: <http://mesinfos.fing.org/cartographies/datasdt/>) (NB: the theme in Lyon was education at first, that is why the theme is ADO/TEENAGER in the mapping)
- MARCH 2018: Publication of use cases that could be implemented in those 3 cities and work on their governance.
- SEPTEMBER 2018: Publication of the final deliverable with scenario of implementation for each cities.

(NB: There will be a bit of delay between the dates written here and their translation in English.)

EVENTS IN FRENCH
